



## **IRS Certification for T3 Motion Electric Vehicles Brings 10% Federal Tax Credit for Customers**

Under this certification, the vehicles are eligible for a tax credit in an amount equal to 10 percent of the cost of a qualified vehicle placed in service by the taxpayer during the taxable year. The amount of the credit allowed for a vehicle is limited to \$2,500 and is available to entities filing federal tax returns.

“With the federal government providing tangible incentives for switching to clean-energy vehicles, these green solutions are fast becoming the transportation alternative of choice. We strongly encourage buyers of the T3 Series ESV to take advantage of this tax benefit as an additional way that T3 Motion vehicles can provide significant cost savings,” said T3 Motion CEO Ki Nam.
